Helmet to meet NFPA Standard

Full length fire retardant clothing

Safety glasses or goggles to meet ANSI Z89.1+S Standard (helmet shields alone are insufficient)

Gloves to meet NFPA Cut Resistance and Heat Resistance Standard

Protective footgear, including impact resistant toe cap

Pen/pencil

Some of the training for this phenomenal two day course will include Air Bag Lifting systems, Timber Cribbing and Strut Support Operations, winching and rigging to name just a few. Attendees will operate at very challenging, yet realistic scenarios featured during the hands-on session. All this extrication training is based upon Big Rigs, such as 18-wheelers and dump trucks.

Fee: \$100.00 per person-includes bag lunch on Saturday and Sunday. A BBQ supper will also be given for all attendees on Saturday night.
